





Status Update on Interoperability Program Work


- We will discuss


- Work continues on production system launch
 - Issue Root Certificate
 - Issue Generic ICA Certificate and Agency Certificate
 - Issue at least one ICA Certificate and Agency Certificate(s)
- NENA holds a weekly Interoperability Program Management meeting with the PCA/FG contracting members (Rick Blackwell, Steve McMurrer, Jeff Wittek, Doug Cunningham, and Dave Sehnert) to report status and discuss immediate action items




- We are working to find one or more 9-1-1 Authorities and/or NG9-1-1 service providers who can be our initial ICAs
 - Actively working with one provider to onboard them as our first subscriber; a recent change to the PKI provider may cause a slight delay. A contract may be in place with the new provider next week.
 - Another service provider is eager to move forward and is working with Eonti and their executive team to determine if they will operate a Discrete ICA or a Hosted ICA
 - Others are moving forward internally, assessing business impact and how best to proceed, and will likely have longer adoption timelines




- We expect that the PCA root certificate will be issued in late April or early May 2023; working with Eonti and DigiCert on scheduling the ceremony
- PKI discussions with the Department of Defense continue;
 CPS was shared with them March 7th 2023, with a review meeting scheduled for April 14th, 2023
- Other important goals in progress:
 - Subscriber terms for the NIOC NG9-1-1 Interoperability Services (for base services as of now, with Forest Guide to come)
 - Onboarding documents
 - Generic ICA CPS (for the NIOC ICA)

 - Will also cover RFP language suggestions and contract impacts





Forest Guide Updates

- The implementation project has begun, and the approved project schedule notes a delivery date of September 13, 2023 for a fully-operational production Forest Guide.
- Intrado and NENA, on behalf of the NIOC, are holding weekly technical conversations.
- Separate in-depth technical workshops have taken place (five so far).
- Intrado has most of what they need to start their work.
- Intrado has now shared a proposed interim data provisioning mechanism; need to discuss.



Forest Guide Updates

- Intrado has provided a contract change order that the NIOC must review, discuss, and approve.
- Other change orders may be required as we clarify requirements with Intrado.
