- PCA Update
 - o The revised Certificate Policy has been posted on NIOC's website
 - o Interest remains high from NGCS vendors in onboarding to the PCA
 - o Initial discussions have taken place with several NGCS providers
 - o These discussions have demonstrated both a lack of clarity on how the pricing is presented and how the PCA should be implemented
 - o Pricing is a barrier to onboarding new subscribers

- As a result, the NIOC is considering restructuring of the pricing models with three new models with the desired outcome to onboard more subscribers to the PCA and simplify the pricing presentation
- o Plans to update the NIOC website with new FAQs and create a pricing page
- o Identify industry events NIOC should attend

• PCA/PKI Pricing

- o Current pricing model is cost prohibitive.
- o Commission is reviewing new proposed models
- o Discussion about potential modeling based on the variety of NGCS implementations across states, DoD, and regions.
- Ms. Melancon and Ms. Jacques will be meeting with NASNA on Friday. They will
 ask for interested members to share their configuration to enable modeling each of the
 proposed pricing models.
- Mr. Sehnert suggested that Ms. Melancon provides a template for data collection from NASNA so that we collect data in a consistent format for the modeling process.

- o Concern about fee fluctuation expressed by Ms. Jacques and Ms. McDowell
